

FACT SHEET: RAINFOREST ADVENTURE DOMINICA

ABOUT

This wild, mountainous nature reserve in the center of Dominica's isolated wilderness allows adventurers to discover plants and wildlife usually hidden in rainforest treetops. Waterfalls, brooks and rivers course through these tropical lands and tumble into a deep river gorge that can only be viewed from the tram gondolas and a suspension bridge that spans the Breakfast River Gorge. Its 350-foot drop offers a breathtaking view and a thrilling experience.

Dominica's rainforest habitats cover 60% of the island's surface. A lack of development, rich volcanic soils and an unlimited water supply create forests with giant trees, enormous root systems and thick, complex hanging canopy gardens. There are no poisonous snakes or harmful animals on Dominica, making this rainforest safe and accessible for all to enjoy.

LOCATION

Rainforest Adventure is located within a mountain cloud forest at the edge of the Morne Trois Pitons National Park in the village of Laudat in the middle of Dominica. Laudat is the village located at the highest altitude in Dominica and approximately 30 minutes from the capital city of Roseau. The island itself is situated between the French Islands of Guadeloupe to the North and Martinique to the South.

Aerial Tram Adventure includes:

- drive through the Roseau Valley and village of Laudat

- Suspension Bridge (optional stop at Tower 19/Top Station to walk through the 300 foot long bridge set 300 feet above the gorge to observe several waterfalls)
- Walk through Chatannier Nature Trail to re-board gondola at Mid Station for a return to Base Station
